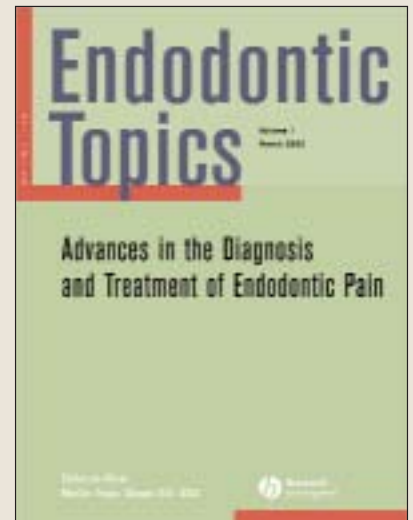

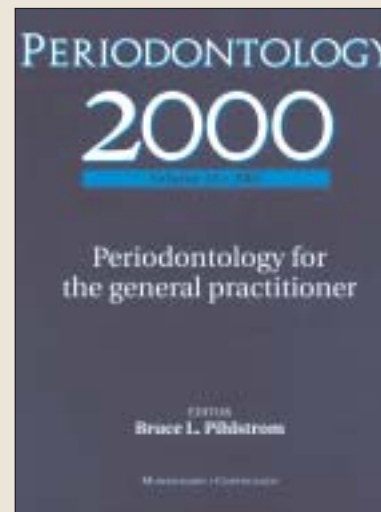

This fourth edition of *Clinical Periodontology and Implant Dentistry* is the ultimate resource on periodontics. 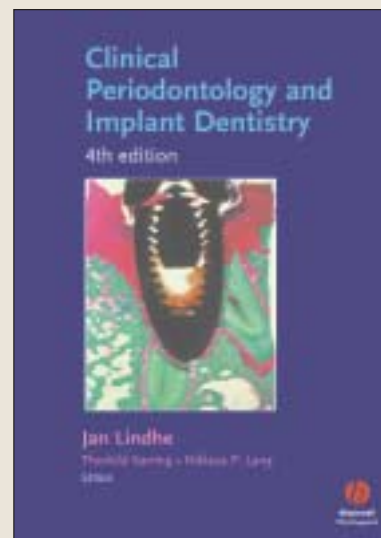

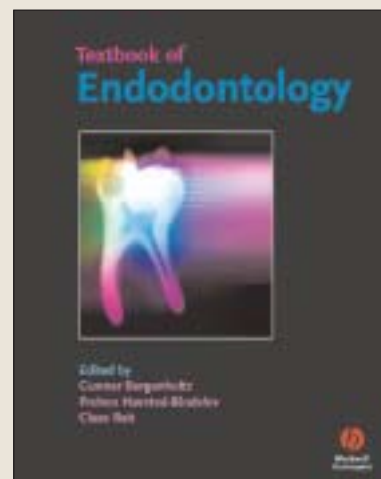

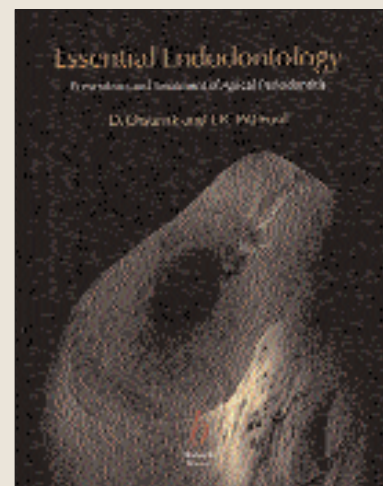

Dental Caries is a major new work on a subject of vital concern to all dentists. It builds on the work of two former books: Textbook of Clinical Cariology and Fluoride in Dentistry to present a definitive resource on caries prevention and treatment. The management of dental caries is central to daily work in dental offices because caries is ubiquitous in all populations, lesion development continues lifelong and caries is the most common cause of tooth loss around the world.

The book's logical structure consists of four parts covering: The Disease; Diagnosis; Prevention, Non-Operative and Operative Treatment and Prognosis. It provides a clear understanding of the disease process, be it at an individual or population level. 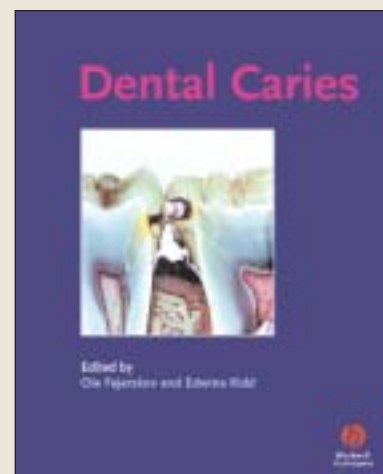

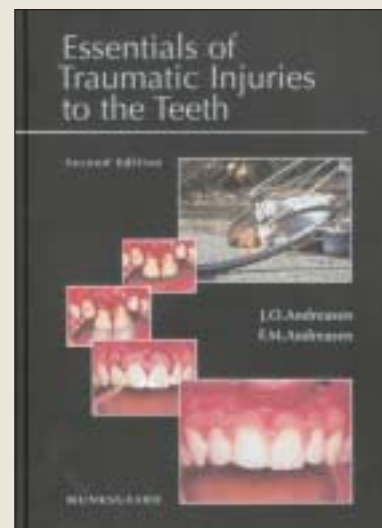

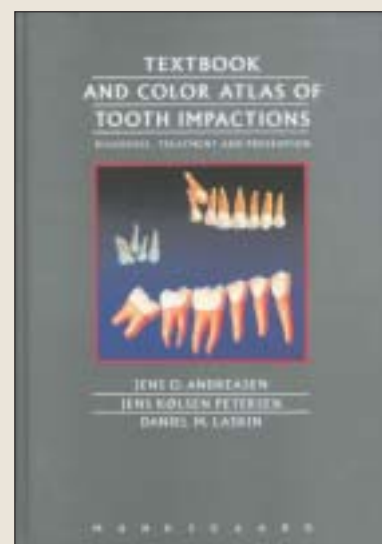

Failure of eruption of permanent teeth (tooth impaction) represents a common, but as yet largely unexplored, problem with regard to proper treatment and prevention. This condition affects almost 20% of the population. Thus, the third molar impaction problem alone represents the second most expensive medico-dental surgical problem in the United States. Apart from that, the sequelae of surgical removal of third molars (that is, mental nerve damage) are the most frequent complaints in dental litigation.

This book includes manifold aspects of tooth impactions such as etiology, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of all types of tooth impactions. The treatment aspect is illustrated by step-by-step colour illustrations of all aspects of the surgical procedure.

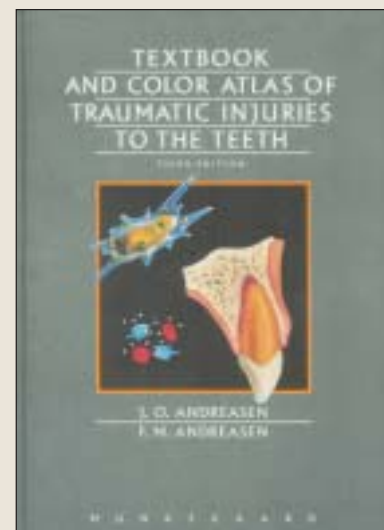
The third edition of this classic text encompasses the full scope of acute dental trauma, including all aspects of surgical, endodontic, orthodontic, pedodontic and prosthodontic therapy after injury.

This edition updates trauma therapy in light of the diagnostic and therapeutic advances made in recent years. New chapters have been added including wound healing and the long-term prognosis of various trauma entities, analysed in co-operation with the Statistical Research Unit of the University of Copenhagen. There are also new procedures for the treatment of anterior tooth loss following trauma, including auto-transplantation of teeth, resin-retained bridges, the use of implants, and reconstruction of lost tissue in the anterior region.

As no type of dental trauma is 'perfect' a given injury type has been generated electronically in order to enhance similarities and differences between various injury groups.

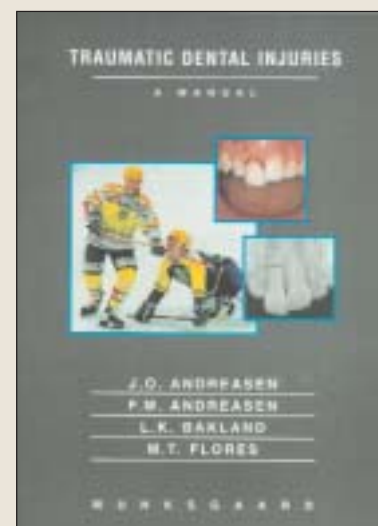
