Curriculum Vita of Speaker, Lecture & Course Outlines

Dr Cliff Ruddle DDS FACD FICD

Dr Ruddle received his dental degree from University of the Pacific, School of Dentistry, San Francisco, California, and completed his postgraduate work in endodontics at Harvard School of Dental Medicine, Boston, Massachusetts.

Dr Ruddle is internationally recognized as a leading expert in all aspects of endodontics. He is an Assistant Professor of Graduate Endodontics at Loma Linda University and University of California, Los Angeles, and is an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Endodontics at University of the Pacific, School of Dentistry. Dr Ruddle is internationally known for providing superb endodontic education as a lecturer and through his clinical articles, videos and hands-on training courses. He is the founder and director of Advanced Endodontics in Santa Barbara, California, and maintains a private practice limited to endodontics.

Clinicians frequently encounter endodontically treated teeth that are failing. The vast majority of these cases can be predictably retreated non-surgically. Ultrasonic instrumentation may be successfully utilized to perform a variety of endodontic procedures. In combination, microscopes and ultrasonics have driven “microsonic” techniques that dramatically improve precision, predictability and safety. Dr Ruddle will address the recent advances in ultrasonics and clearly show a variety of clinical applications in endodontic non-surgical retreatment, including:

- ◆ Removing posts and cores
- ◆ Eliminating obturation materials
- ◆ Retrieving separated instruments
- ◆ Managing transportations and perforations

In the Hands-on course, Dr Ruddle will focus on the clinical application of Hand and Rotary ProTaper systems.
